1. I am the successor of the above-named decedent. A certified copy of the death certificate is submitted with this affidavit.
2. The gross value of the decedent's estate in this State (excluding motor vehicles) does not exceed \$100,000.*
3. No application or petition for the appointment of a personal representative is pending or has been granted in in this State.
4. I am entitled to payment or delivery of the property referred to above and itemized in paragraph #6, by virtue of Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 560:3-1201, as amended, and by virtue of my relationship to the decedent indicated above.
5. I have read and understand Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 560:3-1202:

560:3-1202 Effect of Affidavit. The person paying, delivering, transferring, or issuing personal property or the evidence thereof pursuant to affidavit is discharged and released to the same extent as if the person dealt with a personal representative of the decedent. That person is not required to see to the application of the personal property or evidence thereof or to inquire into the truth of any statement in the affidavit. If any person to whom an affidavit is delivered refuses to pay, deliver, transfer, or issue any personal property or evidence thereof, it may be recovered or its payment, delivery, transfer or issuance compelled upon proof of their right in a proceeding brought for the purpose by or on behalf of the persons entitled thereto. Any person to whom payment, delivery, transfer or issuance is made is answerable and accountable therefore to any personal representative of the estate or to any other person having a superior right. * To determine the gross value of the decedent's estate, include all of the decedent's real and personal property, excluding motor vehicles. Real estate held as tenants in severalty and tenants in common is included, but property held as joint tenants and tenants by the entirety is not.
